# **Impact Mission**

PDA served as an academic network through the DESSI proposal for next generation innovation programs, as reported in the last newsletter. Dessi was not granted as a stand alone pre-study project, yet teamed up with Teknikföretagen's initiative "Net Zero Industry by 2040" where DESSI served as input, addressing the role of Design and Product Development perspectives for

industrial transformation (see fig below). A proposal was submitted by mid-October to form a program office, where PDA together with SPA (Swedish Production Academy) are represented as academic partners in the proposal. The submission is supported by predominantly Swedish manufacturing industries, and the proposal is currently under review. A decision on which programs will be granted to start 2024 will be announced early next year.



# **Nordic Chapter**

The Nordic Chapter within the Design Society meets three times per year (last physical meeting was at ICED 2023, see photo). The purpose is to enhance a Nordic approach to product development in industry, education and research.
